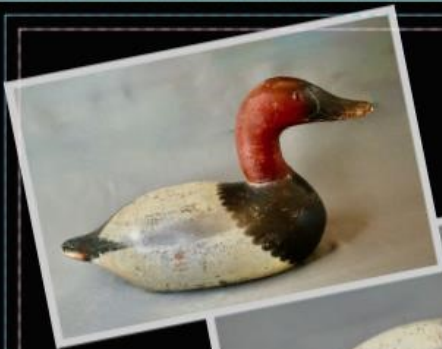

Don Gabelhouse is the owner of these Mason Decoys made at the Mason Factory in Detroit between 1896 to 1924. The Classic Premier Grade drake canvasback is branded on the bottom with "RED DEER" which was used by the Red Deer Hunting Club in Nebraska Sandhills and is pictured in the club's history book by Jon Farrar. The high head Mason Premier Grade Seneca Lake Drake canvasback was a special order decoy, made for hunters in New York. The lower Standard Grade Mason hen canvasback, was my grandparents' doorstep and the first antique decoy I collected.

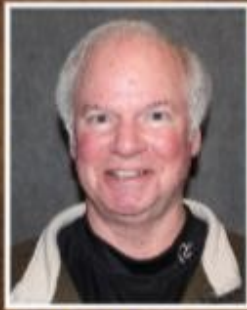

This calendar features CFDCC club member **RAY RICHMOND**, retired "Pipe Coverer" from Wahoo NE.

Ray began his wildfowl carving in the late 90's and progressed rapidly. His first competition was in 2001 at the Pacific Southwest Wildlife Art Association in San Diego where he won three top awards, including **FIRST PLACE** for a White-Breasted Nuthatch, like the Red-Breasted Nuthatch displayed on the following January page.

In 2001, as proof of his artistic progression in 5 or 6 sanctioned competitions, including the prestigious **WARD WORLD WILDFOWL CARVING CHAMPIONSHIP** where he placed **FIRST** for his Decorative Lifesize Floating Waterfowl Gadwall, Ray was awarded the prestigious "**NOVICE CARVER OF THE YEAR**" by the **INTERNATIONAL WILDFOWL CARVERS ASSOCIATION**.

Ray annually supported his hometown of Wahoo's annual fundraiser for Saunders Medical Center Auxiliary with two wildfowl carvings which always auctioned at high prices; unaffordable to many locals. Ray resolved that issue by putting one carving up for auction, the other up for raffle.

Ray commented that he enjoyed carving for donation over competition shows because he could take liberty and have more fun carving a donation bird than a competition bird that required absolute detail representing that bird species. However, he admitted the ribbons and recognition are the rewards for hours of work and precision to transform a block of tupelo wood into a life-like replica of a bird. Further the more realistic the bird is, the more you can capture the essence of a bird. That is what strikes the eye of the judges.

Ray was also quoted once in an article that "When I first started, I thought, boy I'm really good, but as you go along and the more you learn and understand how a bird is put together, your birds start to look more alive."

Prior to ending his carving career, Ray had carved over a 100 pieces of wildfowl artwork, several of which are displayed in public places around Wahoo.

Ray is the father to daughter, Julie; and sons, Phillip and Matthew; who are all very proud of their artistic father."

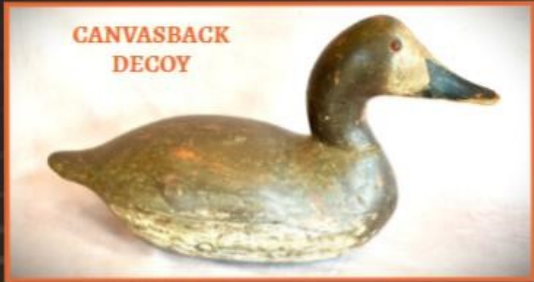

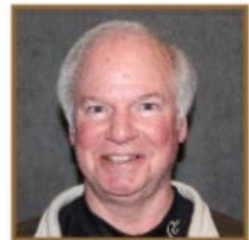

Ray created the base with an indented outline so that the bird sits positioned exactly as he'd designed it to face and tilt. 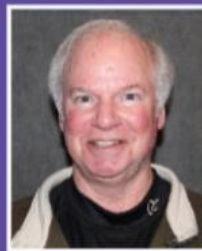
