

Critical Waterfowl Measurements.

A - B Tip of bill to bill lobe.

B - C. Bill lobe to center of eye.

A - C Tip of bill to center of eye.

1. Eye location: Tip of bill to center of eye.

2. Bill lobe to gape = bill lobe to eye

C - D Center of eye to end of nape.

D - E End of nape to end of cape.

E - K End of cape to tip of tail.

F - K End of scapular to end of tail.

G - K End of speculum to end of tail.

H - K End of longest tertial to tip of tail.

I - K End of longest **visible** primary to tip of tail.

J - K End of longest upper tail covert to tip of tail.

L Max. body height from waterline.

M Tip of tail to bottom of decoy.

N Tip of bill to gape.

O Front of breast to sidepocket / cape junction

P - K. Body length.

These are common landmarks used to determine accurate proportions.
